Certificate in Medication safety for clinicians

The Monash Certificate in Medication safety for Clinicians focuses on many aspects of medications safety for clinicians working in the community or hospital settings. The course is designed to help health care practitioners in developing knowledge and skills in the management of medications safety, clarify professional responsibilities and discuss strategies to reduce adverse events and medication errors.

When

The online course will run **three times a year. 30th March 2015, 30th June, 30th September 2016**

Who would benefit?

The course is designed particularly for health care practitioners seeking a deeper understanding of medications safety principles, medications errors and their risks and strategies to avoid them. The course will cover

- General Practitioners
- Health professionals with clinical roles that include administration and monitoring of medications
- Allied Health practitioners
- Community nurses

Enrolment numbers will be capped at 30 participants each time the course is run.

Learning outcomes

At the completion of this short course, Health professionals will learn about the principles of medication and the roles health professionals play in promoting quality use of medicine and medication safety. This course contains four modules:

- a. Medication safety principles
- b. Health professionals 'responsibility in ensuring medication safety
- c. Introduction of Dose Administration Aids
- d. Medication disposals regulations and laws

Teaching methods

A mixture of presentations, case studies and interactive group exercises to apply participants' knowledge and develop their skills. Through pre-reading, participants will be encouraged to develop basic understanding before the course starts. There will be an online Quiz as an assessment at the conclusion of the course.

Accreditation



This course is accredited with the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) for **40 Category 1 QI&CPD** points. A certificate of completion will be awarded to those who pass the online Quiz.
